# TROPICANA FOUNDATION TEAMS WITH 4 CORPORATIONS & GIVES BACK TO 120 FURRY FRIENDS AT SPCA

- Entering into its third year, Tropicana Foundation continues to give back to the welfare of animals through its annual Furry Friends Program.
- Tropicana Foundation teamed up with 4 corporations and reached out to SPCA Selangor.
- This collaborative effort, in conjunction with World Animal Day 2024, saw donations of cash, pet food as well as volunteer manpower services in keeping all 120 furry friends and their living conditions in SPCA clean and tidy.

**Petaling Jaya (23 October 2024)** – For the past three years, Tropicana Foundation ("Foundation"), has extended its support to the welfare of animals through its Furry Friends Programme. This year, the Foundation reached out to SPCA Selangor, a well-respected and trusted animal welfare Non-Profit Organisation since 1958. Tropicana Foundation teamed up with 4 corporations – Capri by Fraser, DF Petrition, Tropicana Golf & Country Resort and Tropicana Corporation Berhad – and donated cash, pet food supplies as well as volunteer services in keeping the SPCA compound clean, and all 120 cats and dogs groomed.

To make this endeavour easier, all SPCA adoptions require a processing fee of RM350 (Dog) and RM250 (Cat).
